### TRANSPORT:

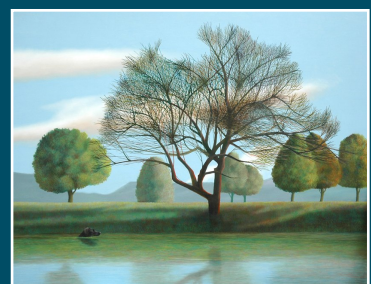
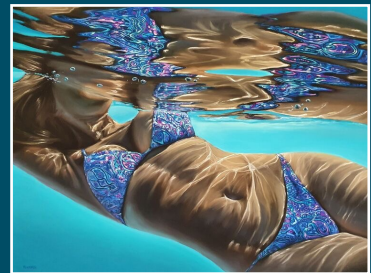
- We desperately need a long wheel-base van and driver to transport and return our display boards. Petrol monies paid.
